

NOTICE TO VISITORS OF RACQUET CLUB VILLAS

The owners of Racquet Club Villas welcome you and hope that your visit to our community will be a pleasant one. You are invited to use the pool, tennis courts and bicycle parking racks that are located throughout the common areas of Racquet Club. To ensure the enjoyment of both owners and guests, please observe the following rules.

Tennis Courts: Access to the tennis courts and restrooms are by combination only. You may receive the combination either from the Villa owner or the Rental Agency you rented through. Please do not give the combination to anyone. All owners and guests have been provided the combination. Non-owners and non-guests using the tennis courts will result in limiting your ability to reserve court time.

- A. Proper tennis attire is required to include shirts and “Soft Court” tennis shoes
- B. Do not play when the court is wet
- C. Courts are to be used for tennis ONLY
- D. Observe proper tennis etiquette
- E. Be respectful of other owners and guests wanting court time

Swimming Pool:

- A. The pool is open dawn to dusk
- B. Children under 16 MUST be accompanied by an adult
- C. Swim at your own risk (No Lifeguard on Duty)
- D. Proper swim attire is required in the pool (No cutoff shorts or jeans)
- E. Observe all posted rules

Bicycle Parking: Parking bicycles in the Breezeways between Villas and under the staircases is strictly prohibited. All bicycles **MUST** be parked at the bike racks located throughout the Racquet Club common grounds. Please comply with

signage that is posted in or near all Breezeways. Bicycle racks are not to be moved or relocated to the Breezeways or staircases.

Beach equipment and towels: Beach equipment (Chairs, coolers, toys etc.) are not to be stored in the Breezeways between the Villas, under the staircases, or on a second or third floor landing. Do not drape towels, bathing suits etc. on the balconies or any exterior part of the Villa.

Open flame cooking devices: Charcoal grills (burners), LP gas grills (burners) and other open flame cooking devices are prohibited at Racquet Club Villas by order of the Hilton Head Fire Department. Violators are subject to a \$1,092 per day fine.

Exceptions – Electric grills and LP gas grills with a water/LP gas capacity less than 2.5 pounds (Camping Stove) may be used.

Pets: Most Racquet Club owners' welcome pets. It is a Beaufort County Ordinance that forbids pet owners from allowing animal waste from entering storm drains. We ask all visitors to be considerate and cleanup after their pets.

Trash: Please dispose of all trash properly. Put all trash into a tied plastic bag and place the bag into a trash can/bin. Do not leave trash bags on the ground as animals will open the bags resulting in trash being scattered over the property.
